The D.H. Lawrence Collection consists of correspondence, typescripts, proofs, photographs and two original drawings from publisher William H. Heineman's files for *The Letters of D.H. Lawrence*, edited by Aldous Huxley (London: William Heineman, 1932. Spec Eng L419/e.). The register provides an index to this correspondence, including information about letters used in H.T. Moore's *The Collected Letters of D.H. Lawrence* (New York: Viking Press, 1962), as well as in Huxley's edition. Some of the correspondents include Dorothy Brett, Edward Garnett, James Middleton Murry, Katherine Mansfield, and literary agent James B. Pinker. This collection was purchased from Hamill & Barker in 1973.
