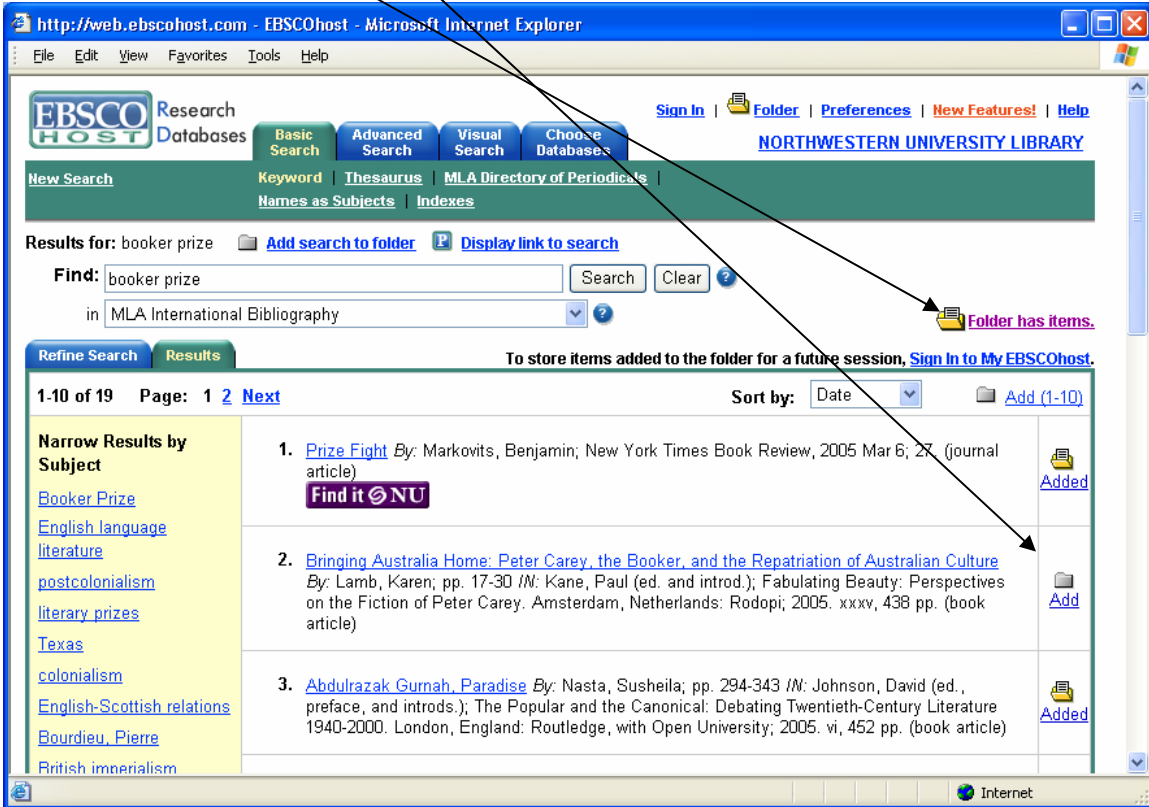
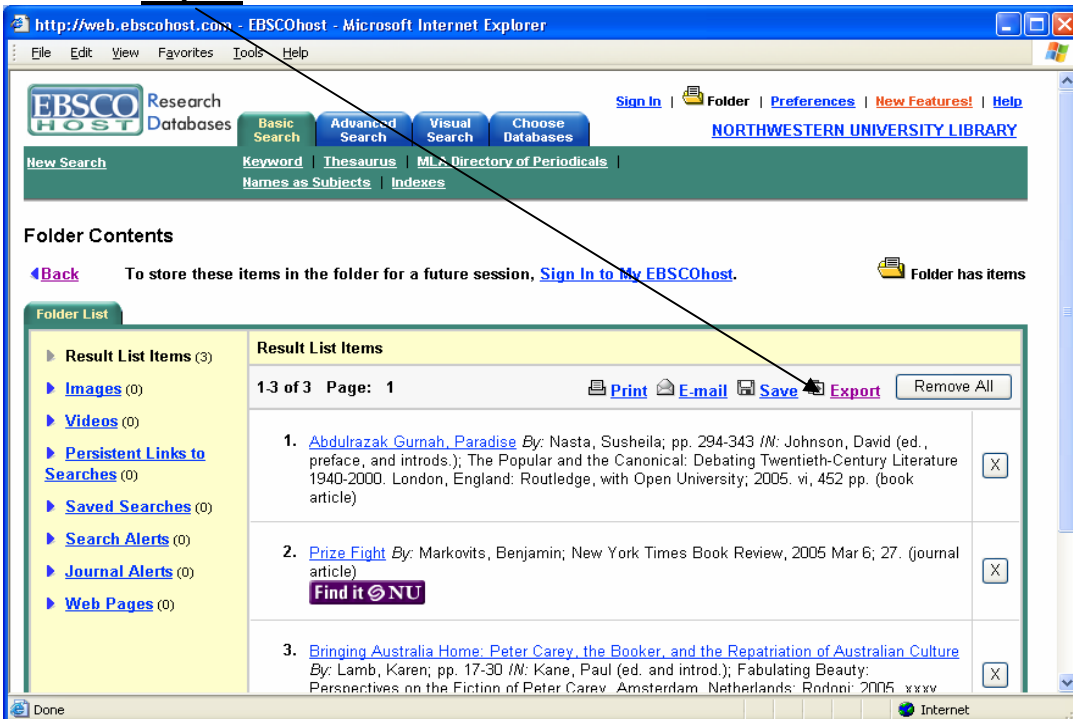


EndNote quick tips: Exporting References from EBSCOhost databases

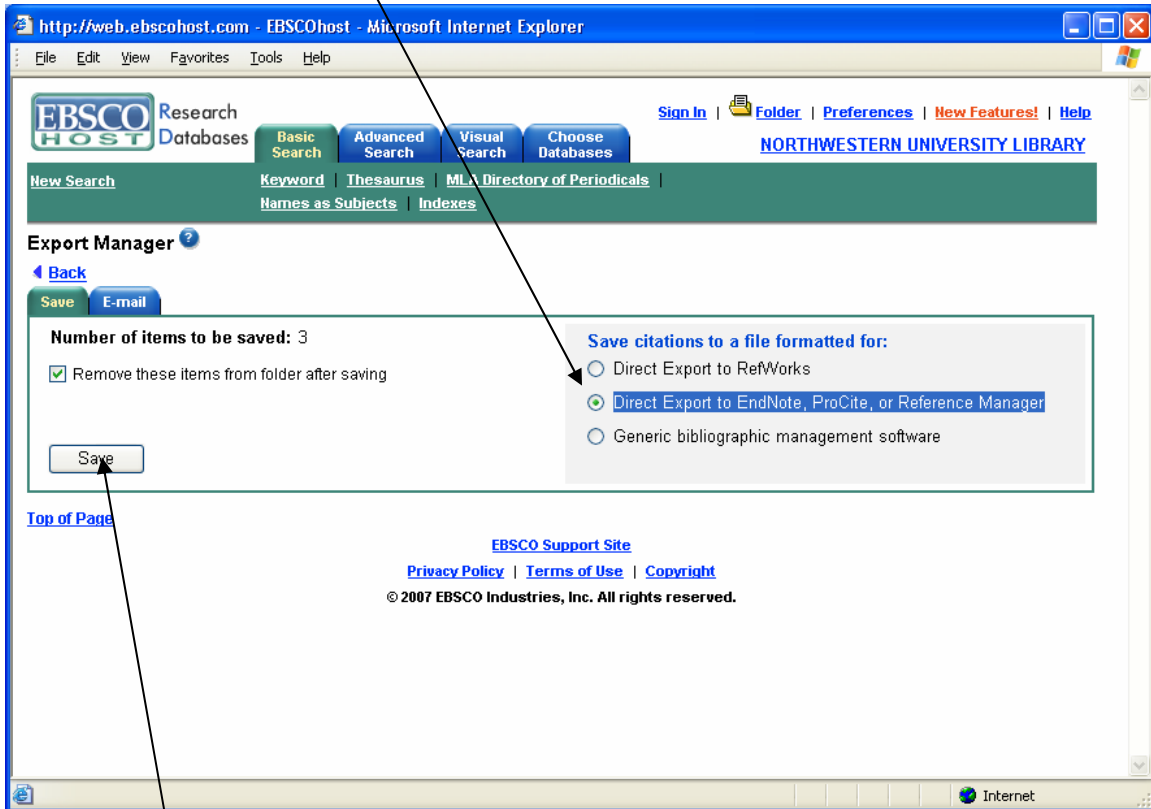
1. Mark records by “adding” them to your folder
2. Click on the “folder”



3. Click “Export”

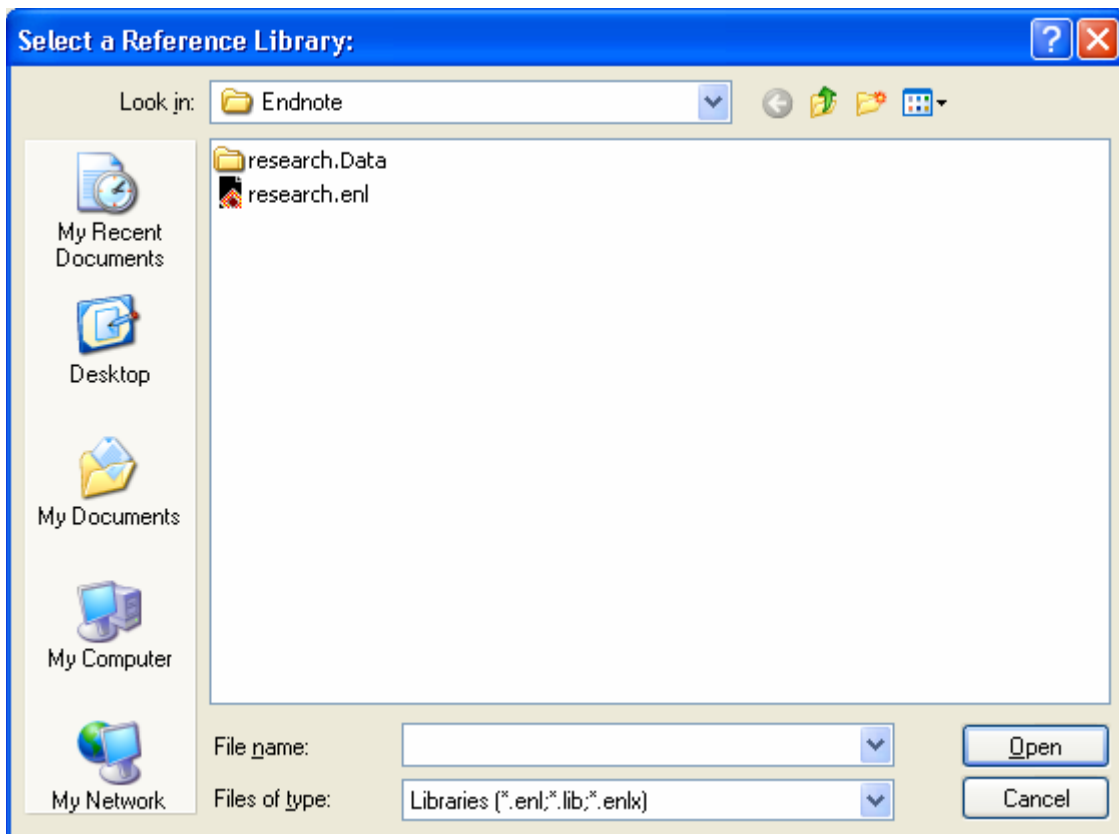


4. Choose “Direct Export to EndNote, ProCite, or Reference Manager.”



5. Click “Save”

6. Select an EndNote library



Additional instructions for exporting records from EBSCO to Macs.

The records should now have been downloaded to the desktop of your mac. They will have a filename that looks like DeliveryPrintSave.asp

Getting the records into Endnote

1. Go to your desktop and find the above file (DeliveryPrintSave.asp)
2. Select this file (click once on it--do not try to open it)
3. Hold down the control key and click once
A list of options for handling this file should have popped up (i.e. open, open with etc...)
4. From the list of options select "Get Info"
5. A Window should pop up with information about this file.
6. The fifth option down in this window of information says *open with* and below it there is a drop down menu.
7. On this drop down menu select EndNote
8. Click on "Change All" .
9. Click on OK.

Now when you attempt to open this DeliveryPrintSave.asp file Endnote should start to open (if not already open).

At this point you will just have to select which Endnote library you want your records to go into and the records should go right in.
