REFERENCE SUPPORT + RESEARCH CONSULTATIONS

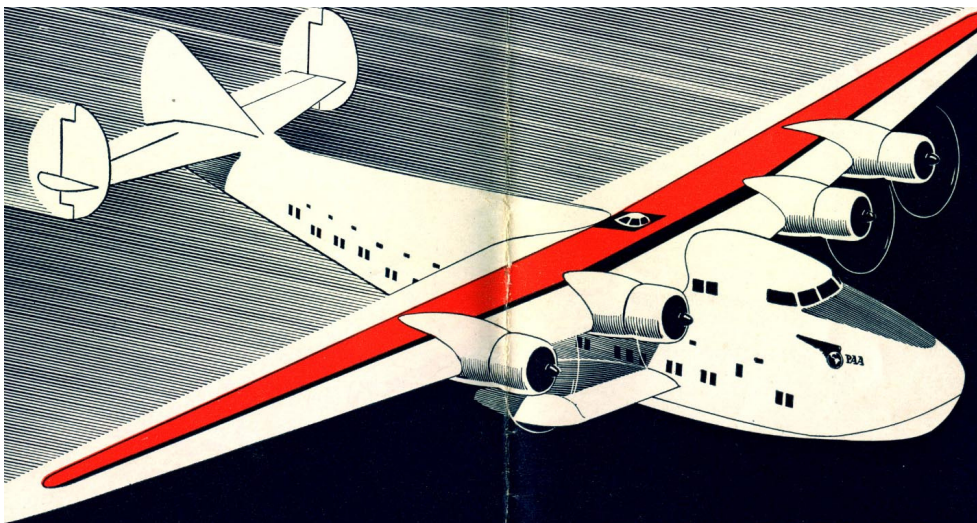

BOOK PICKUP AND OFF-CAMPUS SHIPPING

RARE MATERIALS

Contact us to discuss how our special collections on transportation history tie in with your class. We can arrange for remote instruction using our archival materials and special collections, or set up research appointments for faculty or students to work with these collections.

SCANNING SERVICES

The library will accommodate requests for scans of articles and book chapters. Requests are made using the interlibrary loan system.

INTERLIBRARY LOAN

We anticipate delivery of electronic materials, with a limited ability to obtain print materials for which there may be significant time delays. Use the interlibrary loan system for requests, and contact us with any questions you have.

STUDY SPACES AND CARRELS

Space on the first and second floors of Main Library will be open for individual study by appointment; space can be reserved on the library's website. Graduate students and faculty who would typically have study carrels will be able to keep books on a personal cart that will be ready anytime they come in for a scheduled appointment. No carrels will be assigned this year.

REMOTE PCs AND SPECIALIZED SOFTWARE
